**SCHEDULING ORDER**

2. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, June 16, 2010**, each party will file and serve copies of the pre-labeled exhibits that it proposes to offer into the hearing record. The Department shall label its exhibits sequentially using numbers. The Provider shall label its exhibits sequentially using letters.
3. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, June 16, 2010**, each party will file and serve a list of the witnesses that it intends to call at the evidentiary hearing.
4. By 4:30 p.m. on **Tuesday, June 22, 2010**, the parties will file and serve a statement (under Minn. R. 1400.6950 (2)) detailing any objection to the foundation of a written exhibit.
5. A hearing in this matter will be held at the St. Paul office of the Office of Administrative Hearings, 600 Robert Street North, on **Friday, June 25, 2010**, beginning at 9:30 a.m.
