**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Jim R. Mortenson upon the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry's request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060 and 1400.2080 of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

On October 31, 2014, the Department filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval its additional notice plan and its Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules Without a Public Hearing Unless 25 or More Persons Request a Hearing, and Notice of Hearing if 25 or More Requests for Hearing are Received

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Department plans to mail the Dual Notice to everyone who registered to be on the Department's rulemaking mailing list and to various officials, agencies, and associations.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice is **APPROVED** contingent upon publishing notice in newspapers of general circulation throughout the various geographic regions of the state to inform the general public. The general public may be significantly affected by the rules because the proposed rules may affect the cost and decisions individuals and businesses in the general public, as well as various governments, make about building, renovating, and remodeling structures.
