**ORDER ON REVIEW  
OF DUAL NOTICE AND ADDITIONAL  
NOTICE PLAN UNDER MINNESOTA  
RULES 1400.2060 AND 1400.2080**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge James E. LaFave upon the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry's request for review of its Dual Notice and Additional Notice Plan. The Department seeks a legal review of its material under Minn. Stat. § 14.131, Minn. R. 1400.2060, subp. 2 and Minn. R. 1400.2080, subp. 2.

On February 20, 2014, the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (DLI) filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of its Additional Notice Plan. Under its Additional Notice Plan, in addition to the notice required by statute, the DLI plans to notify:

- All certified building officials involved in code administration. This list includes all municipal building officials responsible for administration of the state building code;
- Builders Association of Minnesota;
- Association of Builders and Contractors;
- Builders Association of the Twin Cities;
- Association of Minnesota Building Officials;
- Fire Marshals Association of Minnesota;
- League of Minnesota Cities;
- American Institute of Architects Minnesota;
- Association of Minnesota Counties; and
- St. Paul/Minneapolis Building Owners and Managers Association.

Based upon a review of the written submissions and filings made on February 20, 2014,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.
2. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
