**FIRST
PREHEARING ORDER**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Eric L. Lipman for a telephone Prehearing Conference on May 25, 2010.

Rory H. Foley, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (Department). Mark A. Karney, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of PAR, Incorporated. Based upon the submissions of the parties,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. By 4:30 p.m. on **Friday, July 30, 2010**, each party shall file and serve a statement identifying any person whom it expects to call as an expert witness.
2. By 4:30 p.m. on **Friday, August 6, 2010**, each party shall file and serve a statement which includes a summary of the facts and opinions as to which an identified expert is expected to testify.
3. By 4:30 p.m. on **Monday, August 16, 2010**, each party will file and serve a list of the witnesses that it intends to call at the evidentiary hearing.
4. The deadline for filing and service of any dispositive motion shall close at 4:30 p.m. on **Friday, August 20, 2010**.
5. The period for discovery shall close on **Wednesday, September 1, 2010**.
6. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, September 1, 2010**, each party will file and serve copies of the pre-labeled exhibits that it proposes to offer into the hearing record. The Department shall label its exhibits sequentially using letters. Respondent, PAR, Incorporated, shall label its exhibits sequentially using numbers.

7. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, September 8, 2010**, the parties will file and serve a statement detailing any foundation objection that goes to the authenticity or completeness of a written exhibit. See, Minnesota Rule 1400.6950 (2).
8. An evidentiary hearing in this matter will be held at the Saint Paul office of the Office of Administrative Hearings on **Wednesday, September 15, 2010**, beginning at 9:30 a.m., and will proceed on successive days through **Friday, September 17, 2010**.
