**FIFTH
PREHEARING ORDER**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Eric L. Lipman on December 3, 2010, during a telephone Pre-Hearing Conference.

Jackson Evans, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (Department). Mark A. Karney, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of PAR, Incorporated. Based upon the submissions of the parties, the Protective Order dated June 12, 201 is modified as set forth below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Paragraph 1 of the Protective Order is deleted.
2. In the place of the deleted paragraph, the following language is inserted:

“1a. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minn. Stat. §§ 13.39 and 13.41, subdivision 4, the Complainant is directed to disclose the names of, and data provided by, the witnesses with whom it spoke during its investigation of the matters set forth in the Notice and Order for Hearing.

1b. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minn. Stat. §§ 13.39, 13.41, subdivision 4, and 13.384, the Complainant is directed to disclose any record in possession of the Department relating to rehabilitation services rendered to the persons denominated as “K.A.” and “C.J.” in the Notice and Order for Hearing.”
