ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.386
AND MINN. R. 1400.2400**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Eric L. Lipman upon the application of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for a legal review under Minn. Stat. § 14.386.

On August 20, 2011, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.386 and Minn. R. 1400.2400.

No comments were received from the public during the comment period.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department, and the contents of the rulemaking record,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The rules were adopted in compliance with the procedural requirements of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 14, and Minnesota Rules, Chapter 1400.
2. According to the 2012 Laws of Minnesota, Chapter 272, Section 96, the Agency has the statutory authority to adopt these proposed rules using the exempt rulemaking process.
