The Minnesota Department of Public Safety sought review and approval of the above-entitled exempt rules. Review and approval of these submissions is governed by Minn. Stat. § 14.386 and Minn. R. 1400.2400.

3. Rule parts 7503.1000, subpart 1; 7503.1675; and 7503.1725, subpart 1 are **APPROVED**. All other parts of the rule were approved for legality under the terms of the March 11, 2014 Order.
