**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.386
AND MINN. R. 1400.2400**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Barbara J. Case upon the application of the Minnesota Department of Public Safety (Department) for a legal review under Minn. Stat. § 14.386.

On October 8, 2014 the Department filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.386 and Minn. R. 1400.2400.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department, and for the reasons set out in the Memorandum which follows below,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The rules were adopted in compliance with the procedural requirements of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 14, and Minnesota Rules, Chapter 1400.
2. According to Minn. Stat. § 171.05, subd. 2(d) (Supp. 2013), the Department has the statutory authority to adopt these proposed rules using the exempt rulemaking process.
3. The adopted rules are **APPROVED**.
