**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.386
AND MINN. R. 1400.2400**

On September 21, 2015, the Minnesota Department of Public Safety (Department) filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.386 (2014) and Minn. R. 1400.2400 (2013).
