FIFTH PREHEARING ORDER

This matter came before Administrative Law Judges Kathleen D. Sheehy and Steve M. Mihalchick on the request of the parties to clarify the procedural schedule.

Based on all of the files and proceedings herein, the Administrative Law Judges make the following:

ORDER

Except for good cause shown, objections by any party relating to the qualifications of a witness or the admissibility of any portion of a witness's prefiled testimony shall be considered waived unless the objecting party states its objection with particularity by motion to the Administrative Law Judges and serves a copy of such objection on the Commission and all other parties by **February 11, 2008**. If an objection is made by a party, the party shall be permitted to lay further foundation for the objection through cross-examination of the witness. Any prefiled testimony that is not objected to shall be admitted during the evidentiary hearings without the necessity of laying foundation for the testimony.
