**ORDER ON REVIEW OF
ADDITIONAL NOTICE PLAN**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Barbara L. Neilson upon the Minnesota Secretary of State's Office's request for review of its Additional Notice Plan under Minn. R. 1400.2060. Pursuant to its Additional Notice Plan filed on July 28, 2014, the Secretary of State's Office proposes to notify the following individuals and associations of its Request for Comments on possible amendments to the rules governing its "Safe at Home" Address Confidentiality Program:

- Various members and committees of the State Legislature;
- The Governor's Office;
- Victim advocacy groups;
- Business and banking community representatives;
- Utility companies and landlords;
- State and local agencies with which participants in the Address Confidentiality Program are most likely to interact;
- Schools;
- Law enforcement, county attorneys, the courts, and the Department of Corrections;
- Organizations and individuals specializing in data practices; and
- The United States Postal Service.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Secretary of State's Office, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
