**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge James E. LaFave upon the Minnesota Secretary of State's Office request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2015) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan filed on December 30, 2015, the Secretary of State plans to provide notice of the rule hearing to legislative committees with fiscal and policy oversight authority in the relevant areas, House and Senate leadership, former Secretaries of State, Governor Dayton, chairs of Minnesota's major and minor political parties, election attorneys, voting equipment and service vendors, local government associations, public interest groups, agencies and organizations representing people with disabilities, and groups representing communities of color in Minnesota.

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.
