This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Jim Mortenson upon the Minnesota Department of Health's request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2015) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Department plans to notify:


- the general public through posting on the Department website and publishing in association newsletters and journals, etc.;
- interested parties who have registered with the Department and through Department subscription services;
- health care providers responsible for reporting and health care facilities whose personnel must report communicable disease and conditions;
- veterinarians and veterinary labs;
- coroners and medical examiners;
- local public health agencies;
- medical laboratories; and
- persons in charge of institutions, schools and childcare facilities.

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.
