**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge James E. LaFave upon the Minnesota Board of Cosmetologist Examiners' (Board) request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2015) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Board plans to notify:

- E-mail the Dual Notice and SONAR to every licensee who has an e-mail address with the Board;
- Post the Dual Notice to the Board's website and Facebook page;
- Offer visitors to the Board's office copies of the Dual Notice, rules, and SONAR;
- Mail the Dual Notice, SONAR, and rule drafts; or email the Dual Notice with links to the rule drafts and SONAR to:
 - the Salon and Spa Professional Association, and the Beauty Certified Education Association, (professional associations for Minnesota licensed practitioners);
 - Aging Services of Minnesota;
 - Care Providers of Minnesota;
 - Minnesota Board of Nursing Home Administrators;
 - Minneapolis Community Relations Access & Outreach Specialist, Mariano Perez Espinoza, who chairs a committee of Latino owned cosmetology salons in Minneapolis;
 - Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry, OSHA Compliance;
 - Minnesota Department of Labor, Construction Codes and Licensing, Plan Review;
 - Minnesota Department of Higher Education;
 - Minnesota Fire Marshal;
 - State Fire Marshal Association; and
 - Minnesota League of Cities.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Board,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.
