**CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S
ORDER ON REVIEW OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.26, SUBD. 1 AND
MINN. R. 1400.2300, SUBP. 8.**

This matter came on for review by the Chief Administrative Law Judge pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.26, subd. 1 (2014) and Minn. R. 1400.2300, subp. 8 (2015).

On June 13, 2016, the Office of Administrative Hearing received submissions from the Gambling Control Board (Board) under Minn. Stat. § 14.26 (2014) and Minn. R. 1400.2310 (2015). On July 1, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order on Review of Rules. As set forth in that Order, portions of the rules were disapproved. On July 1, 2016, the Chief Administrative Law Judge approved the findings of the Administrative Law Judge.

On July 18, 2016, the Office of Administrative Hearings received revised submissions under Minn. Stat. § 14.26, subd.1 and Minn. R. 1400.2300, subp. 8.

Based upon a review of the written submissions and filings, and the Board's Amended Order Adopting Rules,

IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED:

1. The Board has the statutory authority to adopt the rules.
2. The rules were adopted in compliance with all of the procedural requirements of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14 (2014), and Minnesota Rules, chapter 1400 (2015).
3. The final proposed rules were modified pursuant to the Order of the Administrative Law Judge and are not substantially different from those noticed in the *State Register* on May 9, 2016.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The proposed rules, dated July 6, 2016, are **APPROVED** as to legality.

2. The Board is not required to publish the text of the rules when it publishes the Notice of Adoption in the *State Register*.
