**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.389
AND MINN. R. 1400.2410**

On October 26, 2016, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (Department) filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.389 (2016) and Minn. R. 1400.2410 (2015).

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department, and the contents of the rulemaking record,

IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT:

1. The proposed rules were adopted in compliance with the procedural requirements of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14 (2016), and Minnesota Rules, chapter 1400 (2015).
2. According to Minn. Stat. §§ 97A.045 and 84.027, subd. 13a(b) (2016), the Department has the statutory authority to adopt these proposed rules using the expedited rulemaking process.
3. Pursuant to the requirements of Minn. Stat. § 14.05, subd. 2(b), the proposed rules dated October 19, 2016¹ are not substantially different from the rules as originally published.²

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The proposed rule parts are **APPROVED**.
