

Board Meeting Minutes June 18, 2025

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Osuji called the meeting to order at 9:30 am. Board Meeting was held in person and via WebEx.

II. APPROVAL OF BOARD MEETING AGENDA

III. DISCIPLINE MATTERS (Closed Session)

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 13D.01, subdivision 2, the Board moved into closed session for the purposes of disciplinary proceedings.

IV. REPORT OUT: DISCIPLINE MATTERS (Open Session)

Chair Osuji announced Board action from Closed Session as follows:

- 1. **Erin Bakke (Caughron) (FFN 456124):** The Board adopted a stipulation agreement and consent order whereby Erin Bakke's teaching licenses are subject to a one year stayed suspension.
- 2. **Brandon Bunney (FFN 475142):** The Board adopted findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order, whereby Brandon Bunney's teaching license is revoked.
- 3. **Brent Ekstrom (FFN 1027897):** The Board adopted a stipulation agreement and consent order whereby Brent Ekstrom's teaching license is voluntarily surrendered.
- 4. **Tracy Land (FFN 341208):** The Board adopted a stipulation agreement and consent order whereby Tracy Land's teaching licenses are subject to a one year stayed suspension.
- 5. **Morgan Olson (FFN 419900):** The Board adopted a stipulation agreement and consent order whereby Morgan Olson's teaching licenses are subject to a one year stayed suspension.

V. CONSENT AGENDA

VI. PUBLIC COMMENT

Chris Hoehn, Minnesota School Jobs

Chris Hoehn addressed the board to express appreciation for the PELSB licensing team's engagement with current and aspiring license holders at MNSchoolJobs events in 2025. Mr. Hoehn also presented statistics on licensee participation with PELSB at MNSchoolJobs events.

VII. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Out-of-Field Permissions Policy

Dr. Yelena Bailey, PELSB Executive Director, presented previous resolution policies addressing teacher shortage. The board extended the resolution through the end of 24-25 school year. Dr. Bailey stated several community partners have reached out inquiring on keeping the resolutions due to current budget cuts and policy changes. Board members discussed possible barriers for educators that have reached their five-year OFP limit.

B. Board Bylaws

Dr. Bailey presented the Executive Committee's recommended changes to the board bylaws. These changes include:

- 1. Adding the statutory reference on board member removal to the board duties section (page 12).
- 2. Revising the language on board participation in grant review and unit review to add flexibility (page 12).
- 3. Adding an appendix with legislative priorities (appendix C).

Changing the language 'stakeholder' to 'community partner' within the bylaws was also proposed. This language change would be present on pages 8, 10, and 11.

MOTION: Aho moved to adopt the revisions proposed by the Executive Committee, as well as additional revisions changing the term 'stakeholder' to 'community partner'. Shoemaker seconded the motion.

VOTE: All yes.

RESULT: The motion passed.

C. Board Elections

Dr. Bailey presented the nominations for the four open board governance positions. These positions include board chair, board vice chair, and two seats on Executive Committee. Each seat has one nomination: Dr. Payne nominated for board chair, Ms. Aho nominated for vice chair, and Dr. Saloka and Ms. Shoemaker for Executive Committee. The nominees were appointed by acclimation.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Arts Steering Committee

Alina Campana, Minnesota Department of Education arts specialist, and Max Clark-Vail, Perpich Center for Arts Education leadership and data specialist, proposed structural changes for educator licenses. These proposed changes include creating a K-12 Media Arts license, discontinuing the K-12 Vocal and Classroom Music and the K-12 Instrumental and Classroom Music licenses and replacing them with a single K-12 Music license, and retaining the K-12 Dance and Theater license alongside the K-12 Dance license and K-12 Theater license.

Board members raised concerns to the lack of current arts teachers contributing to the initial work for the report. Another concern relates to combining licenses may result in teachers being assigned jobs outside their

realm of knowledge. Concerns for further strain on teacher preparation providers was also addressed pertaining to the educator license structural changes.

The Board has requested for additional information before determining interest in next steps.

The committee met on June 11 to approve the board meeting agenda and finalize items for the board retreat. The next meeting is on July 9.
