

Tiered licensure is coming to Minnesota starting on July 1, 2018. Staff at PELSB would like to offer training sessions for districts, preparation providers, and teachers on the statute, the rulemaking (in process), and the online system for application to tiered licensure.

Anyone can attend one or all the sessions, but the days are broken into focused areas. Day 1 will focus on district questions, impact, and training on the online system. Day 2 will be split with the morning focused on teacher preparation questions, impact, and training on the online system, and the afternoon focused on the impact of all this on current and aspiring teachers.
