**EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATION / POLICE PURSUIT  
TRAINING EXEMPTION FORM**

MN STAT 626.8458, subd. 5, "**Vehicle Pursuits; Policies and Instruction Required**," requires the chief law enforcement officer (CLEO) provide in-service training in emergency vehicle operations and police pursuits to every peace officer and part-time peace officer employed by the agency who the chief law enforcement officer determines may be involved in a police pursuit given the officer's responsibilities.

The training shall comply with POST- approved learning objectives and consist of at least eight hours of classroom and skills-based education every five years.

If the CLEO determines an officer will not be involved in police pursuits, the CLEO must notify POST of the officer's exempt status. Complete the information below if the officer:

- is exempt from the EVO / Police Pursuit training requirement, or
- is no longer exempt and has received the required training.
