# EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATION / POLICE PURSUITS

## TRAINING EXEMPTION FORM

Each chief law enforcement officer (CLEO) is required to provide in-service training in emergency vehicle operations and police pursuits to every peace officer and part-time peace officer employed by the agency who may be involved in a police pursuit (refer to MN Statute 626.8458, subd. 5). The training shall be POST-approved under the mandatory learning objectives and consist of at least eight hours of classroom and skills-based education every five years.

If a peace officer will not be completing the required training, and the CLEO determines the peace officer will not be involved in police pursuits, the CLEO must notify POST of that peace officer's exempt status. This form may also be used to temporarily exempt a peace officer from police pursuits and the mandated training until training may be completed.

The CLEO may complete this form to notify POST that a peace officer:

- is exempt from the training requirement, or
- is no longer exempt and has received the required training.
