Call to Order: Chair Won called the meeting to order on August 7, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.

<u>Report from Juvenile Justice subcommittee, Carl Crawford</u> Mr. Crawford talked about the subcommittee had agreed to close the case that was brought to this group. The resolution is the case adoption by the new bill 260B.009 DNA Collection; Parental Consent, Court Order, Or Warranty Required.

The workgroup is working on creating a training video to assist with building relationships with community and establish what parents should be aware of when juvenile DNA is collected.

Update on State Citizen Review Boards, new leadership and workshop:

The Council discussed asking the Citizen Review boards the following questions:

- 1. What is the charge of your board and what are your parameters/ ordinances/ by-laws? How are you organized?
- 2. How do you define success for your board? What would a successful board look like for you?
- 3. Is your board pro-active or reactive?
- 4. How does the public interact with your board?

Mr. Stier, Mr. Deringer and Mr. Myre believe that there is currently enough oversight.

<u>Update on rescheduling public listening sessions, Hennepin County:</u> Ms. Bartness will send out a toll schedular to the Council for the end of September. Once dates are known, Mr. Monsrud will then schedule the next listening session with Hennepin County.

<u>POST Executive Director Update:</u> Director Misselt talked about the POST Board working on creating a model policy and SRO training for School Resource Officers (SRO).
