

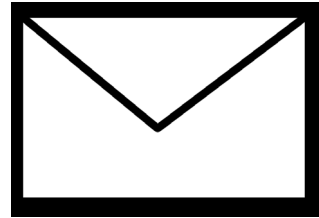
Submit Interconnection Application

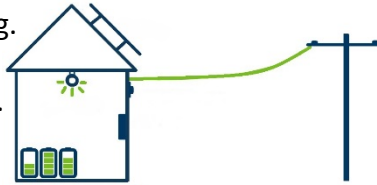


DER Approved and Interconnection Cost Estimate



Interconnection Agreement Signed

1. Construction of DER and any Distribution Upgrades needed.
2. Inspection and testing witnessed or reported to utility.
3. Installation of metering.
4. Utility grants Permission to Operate.
