Just a note to close the loop that I have spoken with you about presentations/proposals for this Friday's web meeting. I will send this note to the DGWG with the final slide deck tomorrow and mention it during the web meeting to avoid perception of ex parte communications.

My understanding is:

- 1) No one is proposing a SRD for IEEE 1547-2018 interim implementation.
- 2) There is concern about the 2004 statewide interconnection standards not being "up-to-date" with even the IEEE 1547-2005 standard.
- 3) There is concern about clarity and transparency when there are multiple documents referenced.
- 4) This is not a staff proposal, but I have heard two possible solutions: a) pull the references out of the relevant documents and include them in the addendum; or b) reference or citation to the technical document for each of the issues and then the specific detail for a given utility in their TSM.
- 5) The MN DIP Attachment 4 is meant to allow for some flexibility in the interim and allows for IEEE 1547-2005, 1547a-2014, 1547a-2015.
- 6) One question: If we go this route, how do we focus on this work as an interim solution rather than potentially opening a can of worms in the TSM review about how utilities are currently implementing technical standards?

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
