

DOCKET NUMBERS EXPLAINED

A docket number consists of five pieces of information:

- Industry
- Company ID
- Docket Type
- Year
- Sequence

An example of a typical docket is as follows: P-421/IC-17-123

P - 421 / SA - 17 - 123

Industry - company ID / docket type – year - sequence

P Industry is phone
421 Company ID is CenturyLink
SA Docket Type is Service Area
17 Year is 2017
123 Sequence is 123rd docket opened in 2017

Industry Types

- E Electric
- G Gas
- ET Electric Transmission
- PL Gas Pipeline
- IP Independent Power Producer
- PT Party
- P Phone

A docket can have more than one industry (ex: E,G-002/M-17-200).

Company IDs

Each company is assigned an ID. (Ex: 421 = CenturyLink; 002 = Xcel Energy; 015 = Minnesota Power). A docket can have multiple company IDs (ex: P-421,405,407/IC-16-400). A 999 in the company ID refers to all companies.
