Dear Chairman Mariani and Chairman Limmer:

To synchronize the effective date of the special session laws with the release of the Sentencing Guidelines, the Minnesota Sentencing Guidelines Commission respectfully recommends that the Legislature postpone, from August 1, 2021, to September 15, 2021, the effective dates of changes to crime and sentencing laws enacted in the 2021 First Special Session.

This recommendation, adopted unanimously (11–0) at the Commission’s meeting this afternoon, is made pursuant to the Commission’s [mandate](#) to make recommendations to the Legislature regarding changes to criminal law, criminal procedure, and sentencing.
