

Areas of Interest in Reranking or Making Legislative Recommendations August 13, 2025

An important component of the Comprehensive Review is addressing the reranking of offenses. Due to the compressed timeframe, it was not possible to undertake a complete reranking of all offenses. Instead, the Steering Committee identified three groupings of offenses for the Commission to focus on. These groupings included CVH, CVO, DWI and Fleeing Peace Officer; Registration of Predatory Offenders and Ineligible Person Possessing Firearms; and Assaults, Domestic Assaults and Violations, and Aggravated Robbery. Between March and July of 2025, Commissioners were asked to complete ranking forms for each of the Offense Groups. The results of the ranking forms were presented at Commission meetings and discussion followed. MSGC Staff then identified those offenses that appeared to have interest in reranking either due to a majority of Commissioners indicating this on the reranking forms or due to discussion. This document includes those identified offenses as well as recommendations for legislative changes. There is a summary table (Table 8) of all of the identified offense rerankings on page 11.

It is the recommendation of the staff that, if Failure to Register as a Predatory Offender offenses are removed from the Sex Offender Grid and added to the Standard Grid, Violation of Predatory Offender Registration Requirements (Minn. Stat. § 243.166, subd. 5(b)) be ranked at SL 2 and that Violation of Predatory Offender Registration Requirements as a Second or Subsequent Offense (Minn. Stat. § 243.166, subd. 5(c)) be ranked at SL 4.
