# Who Receives Custody Status – Cases Sentenced in 2019

March 3, 2022

In 2019, 48 percent (8,320) of the 17,335 cases sentenced had a Custody Status Point (CSP) as part of their total criminal history score (CHS).

## Custody Status by Sentencing Guidelines Grids and Severity Levels

**Standard Grid.** Table 1 displays the number and percentage of cases with a CSP on the Standard Grid by Severity Level. On the Standard Grid, severity levels 7 and 4 had the largest percentage of cases with a CSP. Over 99 percent of CSP cases at Severity Level 7 were for felony DWI (330 cases out of 332). For CSP cases at Severity Level 4, 36.5 percent (707 cases out of 1,937) were felony violation of restraining order offenses, 19 percent (374 cases) were for felony domestic assault, 12 percent (236 cases) were for third-degree burglary, and 12 percent (228 cases) were for threats of violence. Table 2 displays the distribution of cases sentenced with a CSP by grid cell.

**Sex Offender Grid.** On the Sex Offender Grid (Table 3), severity levels H and F had the largest percentage of cases with a CSP. All CSP cases at Severity Level H were for felony failure to register as a predatory offender (FRPO) (217 cases). For CSP cases at Severity Level F, 54 percent (7 cases out of 13) were fourth-degree criminal sexual conduct offenses, 23 percent (3 cases) were for fifth-degree criminal sexual conduct, and 23 percent (3 cases) were for child pornography. Table 4 displays the distribution by grid cell.

**Drug Offender Grid.** On the Drug Offender Grid, severity levels D9, D2, D4, and D1 had the largest percentage of cases with a CSP (Table 5). Over 83 percent of CSP cases at Severity Level D9 were for a first-degree controlled substance offense (5 cases out of 6). All CSP cases at Severity Level D2 (1,969 cases), were felony fifth-degree controlled substance crimes. All CSP cases at Severity Level D4 (49 cases) were fourth-degree controlled substance offenses, and all CPS cases at Severity Level D1 (6 cases) were sale of simulated drug offenses. Table 6 displays the distribution of cases sentenced with a CSP by grid cell.

## Custody Status Point by Offense Type

Table 7 displays the number and percentage of cases with a CSP by offense type. There are seven offense types: Person offenses (including criminal sexual conduct (CSC)); Drug offenses; Property offenses; Felony DWI; Non-CSC sex offenses<sup>1</sup>; Weapon offenses<sup>2</sup>; and “Other” offenses.<sup>3</sup> Felony DWI was the offense type with the highest percentage of cases with a CSP (61.8% compared to the average 48.0%).

<sup>1</sup> “Non-CSC sex offenses” are offenses on the Sex Offender Grid other than criminal sexual conduct (chiefly failure to register as a predatory offender and possession and dissemination of child pornography).

<sup>2</sup> “Weapon” category includes: Possession of a firearm by a felon convicted of a crime of violence, discharge of firearm, and other weapon related offenses.

<sup>3</sup> “Other” category includes: Fleeing police, escape, voting violations, tax evasion laws, and other offenses of less frequency. “Other” category also includes DWI before 2004 and non-CSC sex offenses and weapon offenses before 2010.

## Custody Status Point by Sentencing Guidelines Grid “Zone”

Table 8 displays the number and percentage of cases with a CSP by Guidelines Grid area or “zone.”<sup>4</sup> The Guidelines grids can be divided into three zones which describe the three ways in which a person receives a presumptive prison sentence. The *severity zone* is presumptive prison based solely on the severity Level being above the dispositional line. The *History zone* is presumptive prison because of the person’s criminal history score. The *Mandatory Minimum zone* is presumptive prison because of a statutory mandatory minimum. Additionally, there is a fourth zone of the grid which describes the presumptive “stayed” portion of the grids. (Most stayed sentences include probation and may include up to 12 mos. confinement in a local correctional facility.)

Table 8 can be looked at in two ways: by zone and by grid. The History zone has the highest percentage of cases with a CSP (70.2% for all grids compared to the average 48.0%). For the Standard Grid and the Drug Offender Grid, the majority of cases with a CSP are in the Stay zone (7,502 and 3,506, respectively); and for the Sex Offender Grid, the majority of cases with a CSP are in the Mandatory Minimum zone (404 cases). On the Sex Offender Grid, almost all the cases in the Mandatory Minimum zone are cases of Failure to Register as a Predatory Offender.

## Custody Status Point and the Guidelines Severe Violent Offense List

Of the 17,335 cases sentenced in 2019, 476 (2.7%) were offenses on the Severe Violent Offense List in Guidelines section 8.<sup>5</sup> The offenses listed are all ranked at or above Severity Level 6. Of those 476 cases, 159 (33.4%) had a CSP, two of the 159 cases had 2 CSPs. The 159 with a CSP represent 0.2 % of the 8,320 total cases with a CSP. Of the 159 with a CSP, 56 (35%) had a true prior violent offense (as defined in [Minn. Stat. § 609.1095](#), sub. 1(d)).

Of the 726 cases on the Sex Offender Grid (not including the offense Failure to Register as a Predatory Offender (FRPO)), 121 (16.7%) had a CSP. Of those 726, 14 (2.1%) had two CSPs (meaning they were on custody status for an offense on the Sex Offender Grid other than FRPO). Of those 121 cases with a CSP, 17 (14%) had a “true prior”<sup>6</sup> criminal sexual conduct offense.

### Custody Status and Offense Type and Prior Offense Type

Table 9 displays the percentage of those with a CSP by their offense type and the type of “true prior” in the criminal history. It does not necessarily represent the prior offense from which the case received its CSP. Drug offenses were most likely to have prior drug offenses (63.5%).
