

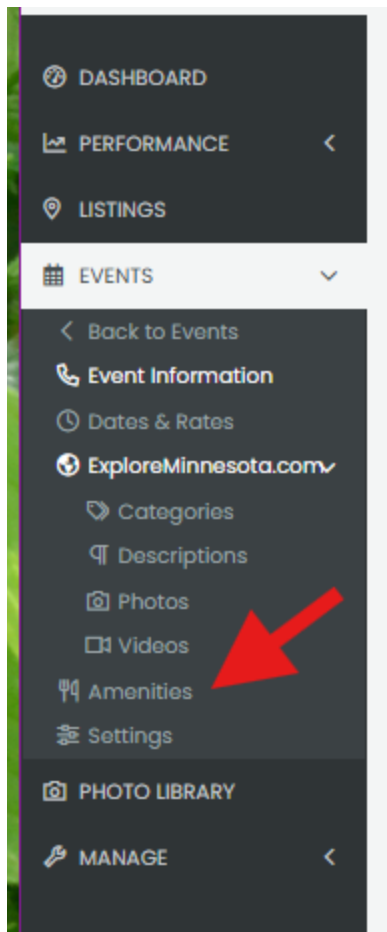

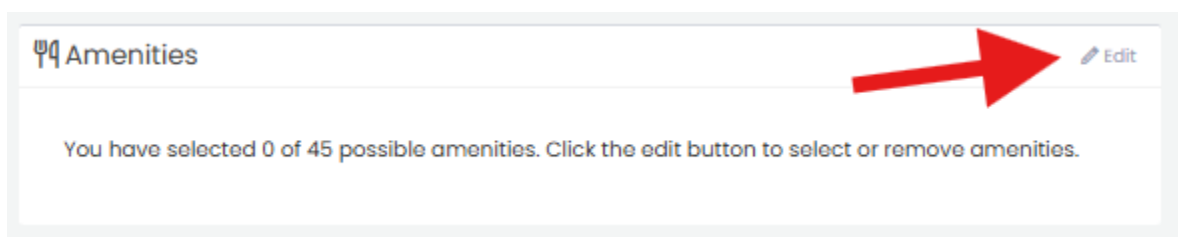
**For existing extranet users:**

Follow the steps below to add a new event listing once you are logged into your extranet account:

1. Verify the event listing DOES NOT ALREADY EXIST.
2. There are two options to create a new event listing:
  - a. From the Dashboard: click on the green "Create Event" button found in the upper right corner.
  - OR
  - b. From the black Navigation menu, click on "Events" and click on the green "Create Event" button found in the upper right corner.
3. Complete the required fields. Keep in mind the more info you supply, the better your listing will be.
4. Select the categories that accurately represent your listing. This determines where your listing will appear on ExploreMinnesota.com.
5. Add the listing description in the Description box. This information will be displayed in the "About" section on ExploreMinnesota.com. Every listing description is required to have a minimum of 100 characters. You may use the toolbar buttons for bold, italic, and bulleted lists within your description.
6. Phone numbers: You must have a phone number. You can add several numbers to your listing
7. Email: Add your business email
8. Website: Include the entire URL beginning with https:// (or <http://>). Do not duplicate URLs.
9. Click the "Create" button at the bottom of the page. Once created, the "Contact Information" page will display.
10. To mark your event as an America 250 event, you will need to be in the event listing profile. The black menu on the left side will display options below "Event Information"; select the "Amenities" option.



11. When you open the amenities tab, it will display any amenities you have selected. If this is the first time you are editing a newly entered event, this box will display "You have selected 0 of 45 possible amenities."



12. Select "Edit" on the upper right corner, all amenities will display- use the check boxes to select appropriate amenities- please remember to review the accessibility amenities while you are here!
