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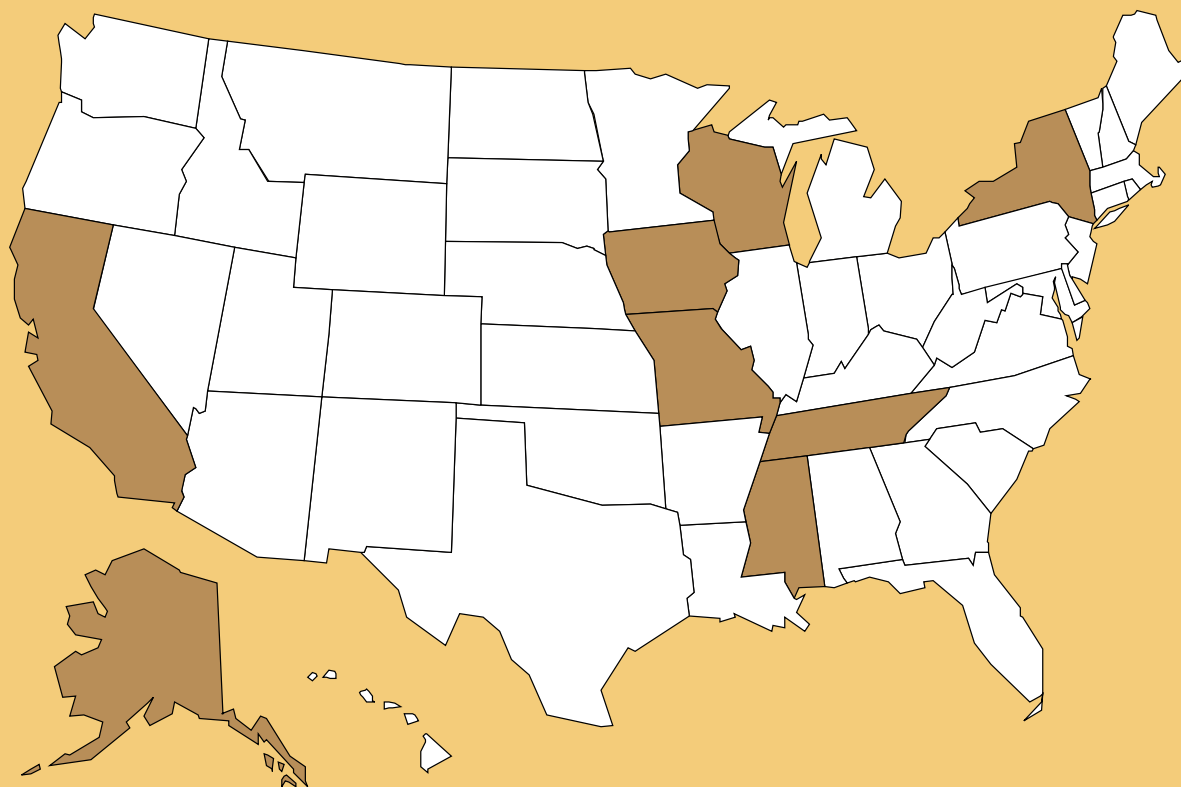

Introduction

This report summarizes the employment and economic outcomes for young adults with Intellectual disability between 2004 and 2011, in eight states and across the nation. Data are reported separately for two age groups: 16 to 21 years old, and 22 to 30 years old. We did this in order to capture possible differences between young adults likely to still be receiving school services (through age 21) and those who have moved on from the education system.

The following eight states are included in this report because they are participating in the Administration on Intellectual and Developmental Disability-funded Partnerships in Employment project: Alaska, California, Iowa, Mississippi, Missouri, New York, Tennessee, and Wisconsin.

Data are drawn from three sources: the American Community Survey (American Community Survey), the Rehabilitation Services Administration 911 (RSA-911) dataset, and the National Core Indicators (National Core Indicators).

American Community Survey (American Community Survey)

The American Community Survey (American Community Survey) collects information annually from a sample of about three million people randomly selected from the 50 states and DC. Topics include gender, age, race, disability, employment, income, commute time to work, home value, veteran status, and other demographic and personal data. Population estimates are generated using the weights provided with the sample data.

The survey is carried out by the US Census Bureau. It is designed to better understand changing communities, with the goal of informing state and national policies. In this report, we compare summary data regarding three groups of people:

1. People without disabilities
2. People with any types of disabilities
3. People with Cognitive disability

Cognitive disability in the ACS is the category that most closely approximates the category of intellectual and developmental disabilities. The ACS identifies a person as having Cognitive disability when a “yes” response was provided to the following question: “Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition, does this person have serious difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions?” However, before 2008 the definition of this group category was slightly different. Participants were identified as having a “mental disability”—instead of cognitive disability—if they reported difficulties in learning, remembering, or concentrating because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition lasting six months or more. Due to this change in disability definition, any comparison of disability data before and after 2008 is challenging.

For each of the three groups, we show data regarding the following variables:

1. Total number of respondents
2. Percentage employed
3. Average annual earnings (in 2011 dollars)
4. Average weekly work hours
5. Percentage with a high school diploma or GED

Rehabilitation Services Administration 911 (RSA-911) Database

The RSA-911 is an administrative case-reporting database that captures characteristics, services provided, and employment outcomes of people with any type of disability who applied or were referred to a state vocational rehabilitation (VR) program. Every year, data are released regarding the people who exited the VR program during the prior fiscal year, regardless of whether they received services or whether they gained employment. About 600,000 people exit the program every year.

The types of disabilities reported in the RSA-911 dataset are those identified by rehabilitation counselors during the determination of eligibility performed at intake. In this report, “intellectual disability” refers to a person for whom code 25 (“mental retardation” in the RSA-911 dataset) was reported as the cause of either a primary or secondary impairment to employment. We show the following data items for people with Intellectual disability in comparison to people with any disabilities:

1. Total number of closures
2. Percentage of people with Intellectual disability
3. Rehabilitation rate
4. Percentage employed
5. Mean weekly earnings (in 2011 dollar)s (in 2011 dollars)
6. Mean weekly work hours

The total number of closures represents the number of people who exited the VR program in any given year. This includes people who were not eligible (a very small number), people who were eligible but did not receive services, people who received services but did not gain employment, and people who gained employment.

The percentage of people with Intellectual disability represents the proportion of people with Intellectual disability who exited the VR program out of the total number of people with any disabilities who exited the program in any given year.

The rehabilitation rate represents the percentage of people who gained employment (formerly Status 26) out of the total number of people who received services (formerly Status 28).

The percentage employed is a broader indicator of employment. It represents the proportion of people who gained employment out of the total number of people who exited the VR program, regardless of whether they received services or even whether they were determined eligible.

The most frequent type of employment reported in the RSA-911 is integrated employment with or without supports. However, the employment variable may also include a few people who reported self-employment, state-agency-managed business enterprise, homemaker, and unpaid family worker.

National Core Indicators (National Core Indicators)

The NCI is a voluntary state-funded initiative coordinated through the National Association of State Directors of Developmental Disabilities Services (NASDDDS) and the Human Services Research Institute. Participating states use a common set of data collection protocols to gather information about the performance of service delivery systems for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Data from NCI are aggregated and used to support state efforts to strengthen long-term care policy, inform the conduct of quality assurance activities, and compare state performance with national norms. Data are collected from a random sample of individuals in about 30 states (www.nationalcoreindicators.org/).

The data collected focus on key areas such as employment, rights, service planning, community inclusion, choice, and health and safety. NCI data are collected by NASDDDS member state agencies with the purpose of tracking performance and outcomes of services provided to individuals and families. In this report, we show the employment outcomes of adults with intellectual or developmental disabilities ages 18–30 in two of the eight states for whom the NCI data were available: Missouri and New York. We show the following data items for the years 2009–2012:

- 1.Total reporting
- 2.Percentage in integrated employment
- 3.Two-week work hours
- 4.Two-week earnings (in 2012 dollar)
