Lamonte is an 11 year old male who is diagnosed to have profound mental retardation due to unknown cause, seizure disorder, spastic quadriplegia, scoliosis, dislocated right hip and exotropia. He is non-ambulatory and non-verbal. He needs assistance in getting in and out of wheelchair and due to his size, this causes problems. He is dependent in all areas of self-care. He needs total nursing care and constant monitoring. He needs daily range of motion exercises and position changing.

Robert has been diagnosed as having mental retardation profound, due to postnatal hypoxia, spastic quadriplegia, seizure disorder, blindness, hearing handicap and a history of recurrent pneumonia. He has no self-care skills. He had surgery in April, 1982 for gastrostomy and fundoplication. Because of his fragile condition, Robert is followed by Independent Nurses, Inc.

She is dependent in all self care skills.

Bernadette is a 34 year old non-ambulatory woman with a diagnosis of profound mental retardation due to unknown cause, accompanied by spastic quadriplegia and scoliosis. Due to Bernie's limited physical functioning capacity, she requires total physical assistance for all areas of self care. She has a history of recurrent aspiration pneumonia.

Sam is a 28 year old male with a diagnosis of profound MR, etiology unknown, encephalopathy with adaptive retardation secondary to unknown prenatal influence, behavior problems, microcephaly. He functions at the profound level of measured intelligence and profound impairment in adaptive behavior. Sam is non-ambulatory, does not creep or crawl, and does not hold objects. He requires total care in all areas of self care and is not toilet trained. He has no expressive speech but does make throaty sounds. He turns his head toward a voice, initiates a smile, but does not imitate words or gestures. Specific medical problems include seizure disorder, bilateral cataracts, scoliosis, functional constipation, deviated nasal septum, chronic GI bleeding, reflex gastritis, and is a Hepatitis B carrier. Maladaptive behaviors include self-abusive behaviors and aggression.

Leslie is a 29 year old man with a diagnosis including profound mental retardation due to hyperbilirubinemia, severe, spastic quadriplegia, choreoathetotic cerebral palsy and chronic pulmonary fibrosis. He continues to function within the profound range of measured adaptive behavior due mainly to his physical limitation. He is non-verbal but does attempt to utilize vocalization, facial expressions and a communication board to express his wants and needs. Leslie has functional vision and hearing. Receptively, it is believed that Leslie understands most of what is said to him, but his behavioral repertoire is limited with respect to responses. This individual is non-ambulatory and dependent in all areas of self care. Leslie continues to have swallowing problems and frequent aspiration-pneumonia.

Amy is a 21 year old female who is functioning within the profound range of MR with a diagnosis of encephalopathy of undetermined etiology with structural and adaptive reaction manifest; seizure disorder, thoracolumbar scoliosis. She is confined to a wheelchair and when laid on a mat does not creep or crawl. Amy lacks bladder and bowel control and has not responded to scheduled training. She is totally dependent in all self care skills. Amy has no expressive language but will make sounds. She smiles, laughs, and looks at the speaker when talked to. She responds inconsistently to her name and very simple directions. She responds to tactile stimulus. Amy has uncontrolled seizures and fibrocystic breast disease. She wears a back brace for scoliosis. She is underweight and is on a ground diet.

Mary is a 29 year old non-ambulatory woman diagnosed as profoundly mentally retarded due to post-natal infection accompanied by spastic quadriplegia, severe thoraco-lumbar rotoscoliosis, seizure disorder and secondary microcephaly. Mary is dependent in all self-care skills such as feeding, bathing, toileting, dressing and grooming. She is non-verbal and responds inconsistently to instructions or commands. Mary will respond to auditory stimuli and her name. She uses a gurney for mobility. Due to deformities she lies on her stomach.
