It would seem that all outsourcing decisions would be made on the basis of cost and quality...a value based decision. Are you aware of data on the overall public/private results on these measures? I think letting the public compete is good.

The issue of the MOU on employees is almost a separate issue from "outsourcing".

The planning in the dept is more along a very different context of consumer choice and direction, ..one that may lead to same results. I would like to see an approach that tries for that dimension along with a different way for the public to "invest" in the housing portion. Co-op housing comes to mind. People are still tied to the "provider" (public or private) to get both housing and services.

I think in terms of the budget, we still need work on deciding what people "need" to remain outside an institution.
