UNIFORMS FOR ATTENDANTS.

(Female)

On and after June 1st, 1915, eil female attendants are requested to appear in full regulation uniform while on duty.

Attendants in charge of cottages may wear uniforms of white with regulation cap, cuffs, collar, and apron-

Regulation uniforms are to be made as follows:

DRESS WAIST Blue and white stripe, regular shirt waist, plain

A few gathers on the upper side of Sleeve.

SKIRT Butterick's No. 10 4" hem, 4" from the floor.

Guffs white, 4" wide. Collers " Merion " (E. W. Marion Co. Troy, N.Y.)

APRON and gathered

into a 3" bend. Bib 6" from neck. Hem on apron 3" wide. Hem on bib 3" wide.

Strap across shoulder 3" wide. The apron to be as long as the dress skirt.

CAP On fold from top to bottem 11". Width 18".

Front 7 on the feld. Front lap 32 . Width at bottom 12" .
