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

Mr. Heffelfinger offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, it is an established fact that there are not institutional facilities available in the state institutions for the committed feeble-minded wards in need of such care, and that there is constant rumor that the bed capacity for the committed mental insane is also inadequate; and it is an established fact that there have not been any new institutions established to fulfill the purpose of the senile commitment law passed by the last Legislature,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this situation be called to the attention of the Governor of Minnesota, the Director of the Division of Public Institutions and the Hennepin County delegation so that they may complete the necessary plans to meet these problems before the adjournment of the present session of the Legislature.
