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2,920 - 1,986 - 934; the present dormitories are overcrowded to the extent of at least 934 beds or 47 per cent. There are 11 beds located in rooms more than 3 feet below grade which should be discontinued for patients' use. It should be pointed out that certain areas which do not constitute useable space such as those occupied by radiators, corridors to fire exits, lockers, wardrobes, etc., have not been deducted from the above calculations thereby making the crowding even greater than the 47 per cent shown.
