SUBJECT: Report of Events for May, 1960.

On May 12 I attended the morning session of the psychologists' meetings and in the afternoon heard Dr. Heiser's talk.

I accompanied 2 B.A. students to Rogers where we interviewed Mr. Roach to try and set up a schedule for some 20 B.A. students for summer volunteer work, (probably picnics and soft ball).

I spoke to Dr. Haven's Psych. class in the Conference Room on May 19 - with the hope that some students will volunteer their services much as the St, Olaf students have done.

A meeting was held the evening of May 26 at 8:00 p.m. to organize a Volunteer Council. Five staff members were present and six volunteers representing several groups. (3 from religious area, Lions Club, Mrs. J.C.'s, and ARC).
