Training Exercises, Fiscal 1960-61

In reply to your memo of August 4, we desire to give you the following information:

On October 5, 1960, the Matienal Association for Retarded Children Vorkshop on Public Institutions (pertion of annual national meeting) was held here, consisting of tours of our facilities and panel of speakers including a parent and superintendents from Indiana and Visconein. Professional groups involved were staffs from Owntonna State School and Faribault State School and Hospital. He fees.

During the Vinter Quarter, 1961, the Mankato State College, 3 credit course, Mucation of Mentally Retorded with Dr. Haily Reuveatte, instructor, was attended by some of our staff and teachers from southern Minnesota. Regular credit fees were charged by the college.

During the Spring Quarter, 1961, Mankate State Gollege effered a 3 credit course, "Teaching of Mentally Retarted", with Mr. Brace Matteon, instructor. Some of our staff and teachers from southern Minneseta attended. Regular credit fees were charged by the college.

Lectures and tours were conducted by our Mincation Department on three separate occasions throughout the year to University graduate students, and undergraduates from St. Cloud and Mankato State Colleges. He feec.

Rev. Bert Streufert, our Chaplain, conducted lectures and tours to teachers of the Summer School of Christian Minestion, spensored by Minnesota Scancil of Churches, Faribault; Senior class of Lather Sominary, St. Fath; and Chaplain's Clinical Factoral Training group, Luther Sominary, St. Feel.
