SUBJECT: Visits by Dr. Russell Barton

The work schedule for Dr. Barton's consultations with the Department of Public W lfare and the institutions in the Medical Services Division is as follows:

Phase I - Between now and June 24, inclusive

Plus time for break, questions, etc.

- 2.4 Those attending the presentations at the Institution Visits should be as many as possible personnel, including night staff, who have not or will not have attended the Institutional Assemblies. Through this means we hope to get the Dehumanization message to all hands, or as many as we can. For this reason, the talks are scheduled at a time of day that will give the best chance for including personnel on the morning and evening shifts. Attendance open to all hospital employees including those who have already been to Institutional Assembly and may want to hear Dr. Barton.

During the last five weeks (June 24 to July 31) of Dr. Barton's visit, he and Jos Lucero will work intensively with certain wards in various institutions in the system. This study will try to further validate the Institutional Neurosis measurement scales and test the applicability of the Institutional Neurosis concept and a working instrument in upgrading hospital wards. The exact methodology has not been worked out yet.
