MONIHLY STATISTICAL REPORT
MINNESOTA STATE INSTITUTIONS
July, 1967

On July 31, 1967 there were 11,358 persons in residence in the institutions under the Department of Public Welfare, a net decrease of eight from June 30, Most of the institutions showed only small changes in population during July, as may be noted in Table I, The July 31 institutional population included 5,081 mental hospital patients (4,807 mentally ill and 274 inebriates), 5,319 mentally retarded (5,665 including patients on temporary leave), 743 patients in state nursing homes, 116 crippled children in Gillette Hospital, 54 emotionally disturbed children in the Minnesota Residential Treatment Center and 53 tuberculosis patients (eight of whom were mental patients) in Glen Lake State Sanatorium.

There was little net change in the number of hospitalized mentally ill during July. However, the two month decrease may 31-July 31 of 170 was only slightly less than the decrease of 199 during the comparable two month period a year ago. Turnover was less during June-July, 1967 than a year ago: 94 fewer mentally ill patients entered hospitals, 54 fewer were released and 11 less died during these two months of this year than last. The greatest decrease was among first admissions: 333 during June-July, 1967 compared with 399 during the same two months a year ago. Both voluntary admissions and commitments were down from a year ago, but 58 percent of all admissions (48 percent of all patients entering) were voluntary during June-July, 1967 compared with 55 percent of all admissions (42 percent of all patients entering) during June-July, 1966.

During July, 1967 the Anoka tuberculosis unit was completely closed and the last eight patients were either returned to their home institutions or sent to Glen Lake State Sanatorium for further tuberculosis treatment. The tuberculosis unit at Anoka was opened in 1950 and during the period 1952-1954 had an average daily resident population of more than 400. The population began to drop in 1955 and had decreased to less than 200 by 1959. During fiscal year 1966-67 the average daily resident population of the Anoka tuberculosis unit was only 32.

As of July 31, 1967 there were 53 tuberculosis patients in Glen Lake State Sanatorium, including eight who were mental patients and therefore classed as part of the total mental hospital population. The monthly report for Glen Lake has been revised (see Table?) to show the various classifications of patients under care. Glen Lake's mental patient population is also shown in Table II-B as a special unit of the mental hospital population.

* Mental hospital population totals including mental patients tinder treatment at Glen Lake were 5,265 (4,980 mentally ill) on Hay 31, 1967 and 5,103 (816 mentally ill) on June 30, 1967.
