MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT
MINNESOTA STATE INSTITUTIONS
SEPTEMBER, 1967

There were 11,780 persons in residence in the institutions under the Department of Public Welfare on September 30, 1967. These included:

4,944 patients in mental hospitals (4,631 mentally ill and 313 inebriates)

5,487 patients in institutions for the mentally retarded (5,557 including those on temporary absence)

762 patients in state nursing homes

284 children in the School for the Deaf

98 children in Braille and Sight-Saving School

114 crippled children in Gillette Hospital

43 children in Minnesota Residential Treatment Center, and

56 tuberculosis patients in Glen Lake State Sanatorium (including 8 mental patients).

During the first quarter of fiscal year 1967-68 the number of hospitalized mentally ill has shown a net decrease of 185, with 775 fewer mentally in in residence in state hospitals September 30, 1967 than a year ago, continuing the downward trend which began more than twelve years ago. The inebriate population, with a net increase of 26 since June 30, fluctuates considerably from month to month and is now 24 over the number in residence a year ago. The mentally ill populations of all hospitals except Rochester have shown some decrease in the past three months and all have shown at least small decreases during the past year, with the largest decreases at Fergus Falls and St. Peter (see Table I).

Fewer mentally ill patients entered the hospitals during July-September, 1967 than during the corresponding three months of 1966. The first quarter of 1967 there were 475 first admissions and 618 readmissions and returns from provisional discharge of mentally ill patients compared with 501 first admissions and 650 readmissions and returns during July-September, 1966, There have also been slightly fewer releases and deaths in hospital so far this year than last (see Table II-A). Although there has been a small decrease in voluntary admissions, a slightly larger proportion of all mentally ill admissions have been voluntary so far this year (58 percent; than last (56 percent).

The number of mentally retarded patients in residence has been decreasing for the past five years. Since June 30 the number in residence plus those on temporary leave has dropped 136 (see Table HI), with a net decrease of 263 in residence this past year. So far this fiscal year a total of 165 mentally retarded patients have been released, 45 more than during the first three months of fiscal year 1966-67. As of September 30, 1967 there were 296 mentally retarded patients on trial placement, 72 more than on June 30 and 104 more than on September 30, 1966.
