The objectives and directions of the Grandview Unit were discussed and it was agreed that the following kinds of objectives were to be strived for during the next three month period:

- 1) There will be an attempt to increase the excellent progress made in Behavior Modification programs. This happily will be done with! supplemental staff to increase the amount of time residents spend in DAC's and should occur sometime during November.
- 2) A second objective was to increase the number of referrals to appropriate community facilities and the necessity of the team to become more knowledge-able in services provided in these community facilities so as to make appropriate placements.

3) A major emphasis would be on the development of programs in Seneca. An excellent start has been made in this area with the support of the ward staff, plus consultation from physical therapy and occupational therapy and efforts will be made to
