East Grove goals for the next three months

After a very productive discussion in which a number of programs were discussed, the following objectives were established for East Grove during the next threemonths:

- 1. Set up a day activity center in Daisy
- 2. Set up day a c t i v i t y c e n t e r s in Poppy
- 3. Begin behavior modification program in Poppy
- 4. Increase the quality and quanlity of volunteer programming in East Grove Unit
- 5. Increase the number of referrals in the hands of county agencies. The current 1 e v e l is 10; at the next 3 month period we would l i k e at 1 e a s t 25 r e f e r r a 1 s to be in the hands of processing counties.
- 6. Extend physical care programs in Willow
- 7. Develop the following in s e r v i c e t r a i n i n g programs in the next 3 months.
 - A. Contact the Speech Therapy Department and see if training can be given to p s y c h i a t r i c t e c h n i c i a n s to develop s o r e appropriate speech in Daisy residents
 - B. Send selected members of the Willow staff to Wisconsin Central Colony for furthertraining in use of adaptions, wheelchairs and programming for physically handicappedresidents.
 - C. Develop a behavior modification training program for selected staff in East Grove Unit.

It's recognised that all these goals may not be met, but this gives us a direction to work for in the next several months, I would suggest a fairly wide dispers al of these program goals so that all staff members can be aware of the kinds of things that we are working on.
